Sub : Financial assistance to retired CISF personnel from Central Welfare Fund-  
Regarding.

Instances have come to notice when CISF Units have forwarded the cases of retired personnel for grant of financial assistance from Central Welfare Fund for their treatment. It has been observed that the Force personnel while proceeding on retirement have opted for availing of Rs.100/- per month as fixed medical allowance; instead of availing CGHS facilities provided by the Govt.

2. Central Govt. Health Scheme (CGHS) is available to all Central Govt. employees and pensioners. Their families can also avail of the Scheme, if they are totally dependent on the employee / pensioner.
3. The facilities under CGHS mainly include –
  - (i) Consultation with the Medical Officer at CGHS Dispensary, Polyclinic or hospital;
  - (ii) X-ray, Laboratory and other diagnostic facilities.
  - (iii) Supply of medicines, etc.
  - (iv) Hospitalisation facilities.
  - (v) Reimbursement of cost of implants for heart ailments, hearing Aids, intra-ocular lens etc.
4. Such facilities can be availed at CGHS Hospital / Dispensaries, Govt. Hospitals / Referral Hospitals. Besides, in order to make availability of medical facilities more comprehensive and for certain specialized treatments not available in Govt. hospitals, certain private hospitals have also recognized under the Scheme.
5. Pensioners availing the CGHS facilities are required to make a lump sump payment to CGHS authorities depending upon the pension.
6. All personnel working under administrative control may please be apprised about the CGHS facilities provided by the Govt. to serving and pensioners, so that they can avail these facilities after retirement.
7. Pensioners may be informed through letters containing all the details of scheme.
