### Industrial Tragedy Averted by CISF

CISF Fire Wing personnel successfully doused fire at multiple levels of boiler & a conveyor belt at NLC Neyveli (TN)

On 07.05.2020 at about 1645 hrs, a massive fire broke out in the boiler and the bunker area of Unit-6 of NLC, Neyveli (TN) due to an explosion. On-duty crew of CISF Fire Service Wing deployed at Thermal Power Station-2 of NLC Neyveli along-with fire tenders, rushed to the spot immediately to contain & extinguish the fire.

On reaching the spot, it was noticed that multiple levels of boiler and the bunker area of Unit-6 were under fire. A section at 40 mtrs height of the conveyor belt at the bunker area, had also caught fire. After taking necessary precautions in consultation with the concerned area in-charge of NLCIL, CISF Fire Wing personnel formed operational teams and started extinguishing the fire. After rigorous efforts, the fire was controlled by 1900 hrs. Two NLCIL employees and six casual labourers of NLCIL were injured in the fire incident and were shifted to NLC Hospital. The good work done by the CISF Fire Wing personnel, was appreciated by the Management and local authorities.

On 07.05.2020 at about 0445 hrs, CISF Unit VSP Visakhapatnam received information of styrene gas leakage in a private firm LG Polymers, Gopalapatnam, Visakhapatnam, from local police. Styrene is a poisonous, inflammable gas used in plastic engineering. Immediately, CISF Fire Wing personnel of the unit with protective equipment and foam tender, rushed to LG Polymers plant and joined the rescue operation with local administration. 20, CISF Fire Service Wing personnel with foam tender, actively participated in the joint operation with local authorities, state fire service. Lives of 20 people were saved during the operation. District administration acknowledged the good work done by CISF personnel.
