

CISF STAFF HELPS WOMAN DELIVER BABY AT ANAND VIHAR METRO STN

NEW DELHI: A woman constable of the Central Industrial Security Force (CISF), with the help of other female passengers at Anand Vihar Metro station in east Delhi, helped a pregnant woman, who went into labour, deliver a healthy baby at the station on Thursday, said officials.

According to officials, around 3.25pm on Thursday, the woman passenger, waiting for a Metro on platform number three, suddenly developed labour pains, following which CISF constable Anamika Kumari and other passengers came to her aid.

"Kumari, along with the help of other female passengers on the Metro station platform, helped the pregnant lady to deliver a healthy baby at the platform itself. Sheets were used and the woman was covered from all sides," said a CISF official.

The woman and her newborn baby were subsequently taken to a nearby hospital in an ambulance.

"The lady and her husband thanked CISF personnel profusely for our prompt response..." the security force said in a statement issued on Thursday.
