

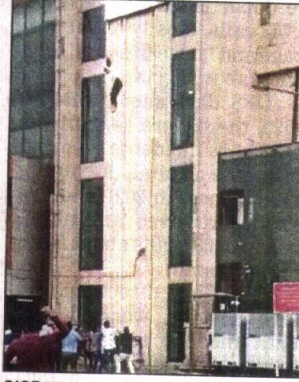
## Woman jumps from Metro station building, rescued by CISF; dies in hospital

**New Delhi:** A woman rescued by Central Industrial Security Force (CISF) personnel while trying to commit suicide at Akshardham Metro Station on Thursday morning died later due to her injuries.

The 22-year-old woman, from Punjab's Hoshiarpur, jumped off the ledge at platform number two around 7.30am, but CISF personnel, with the help of civil employees, caught her on a blanket. She was admitted to a hospital, where she died around 8.45pm.

According to sources, the woman was undergoing treatment at a hospital in Gurgaon for the past few days. As she was spotted in the morning, "one team tried to dissuade her, while another team, with the help of civil employees, arranged for a blanket to catch her," said a CISF official. The reason behind the step was not immediately known, said sources.

A video of the incident was widely shared on social media. "Due to the severity of fall, she sustained grave injuries on her leg," said a CISF official. "We suspect she had internal injuries due to the impact," a senior officer said, adding that they were investigating the reason behind the step.
