# SUB:- FRAMING OF RECRUITMENT RULES FOR THE POST OF CONSTABLE (KENNELMAN) (NEW POST NEW RRS) IN CISF: REG.

It is intimated that consequent upon creation of new post, the framing of Recruitment Rules for the post of Constable (Kennelman) in CISF is under consideration for approval of MHA/MOL.

		Note: The crucial date for determining the age limit shall be the closing date for the receipt of		



applications from candidates and not the closing date prescribed for those in Assam, Mizoram, Manipur, Nagaland, Meghalaya, Arunachal Pradesh, Tripura, Sikkim, Ladakh Division of Jammu and Kashmir State, Lahaul and Spiti District and Panji Sub-division of Chamba District of Himachal Pradesh, Union territory of Andaman and Nicobar Islands and Union territory Lakshadweep.

In the case of Ex-servicemen (as defined in Clause (a) of Rule 5 of theEx-servicemen (Re-employment in Central Civil Services and Posts) Amendment Rules, 2012} the extent of service rendered by them plus three years to be deducted from the actual age and the resultant age should not exceed twenty five years. The upper age limit shall be further relaxable upto 05 years in case of SC/ST and 3 years in case of OBC candidates on production of caste certificates in the prescribed format.

- (ii) Candidates must not suffer from knockknees, flat foot, varicose veins and squint in the eyes. They must be in good mental and bodily health and free from any physical defect likely to interfere with the efficient performance of duties.
- (4) Must qualify the physical efficiency and written tests.

#### (a) Ex-servicemen / Re-employment:

Retired or released Army personnel who have held the substantive rank of Constable (Kennelman) or equivalent rank in the Navy/Air Force (Those holding equivalent honorary ranks willnot be eligible).

They should fulfill the following requirements, namely:-

### (a) Educational Qualification:

(i) Matriculation/10<sup>th</sup> class pass or equivalent or having Army 1<sup>ST</sup> Class Certificate or equivalent of Navy/ Air Force, who has put in not less than 15 years of service as on closing date with Armed Forces of the Union shall be considered eligible for appointment to the posts being advertised. Those non-matric Exservicemen and who has not completed 15 years of service as on the last date for receipt

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of applications are not eligible.

(ii) Not less than two years experience in handing of animals from Government Veterinary hospitals or dispensary or Veterinary College or Government Animals Farm;

#### (b) Medical Standard:

- (i) Should possess medical category SHAPE -I and equivalent to that prescribed for Ex-Military personnel.
- (ii) Visual Standard (age at entry 35-55 Years)

# 3. Refraction

Hypermetropia: +2 DS

Myopia: 2.5 DS (including cylinder)

Note.- Age related physiological presbyopic changes are likely to occur above 35 years so age wise presbyopic changes relaxation is permitted as mentioned below for near vision (this is in addition to that above relaxation already provided for distant).

- i. +1 DS upto 40 years
- ii. +2 DS upto 50 years
- iii. +3 DS 51 60 years & above

Note 1. - In right handed person, the right eye is better eye and vice versa. Binocular vision is required. PRESBYOPIC changes and refractive errors are common after the age of 35 years.

Note 2. - Short listed candidates will undergo same medical examination as for other candidates and should be declared medically fit.

- (c) Character: Very Good/ Exemplary.
- (d) Physical standard: Total relaxation of physical standards for ex-servicemen.
- (e) Break in Service: Not more than three (3) years.
- Relaxation for ex-servicemen shall be as per the instructions issued by the Central Government from time to time.
