Sub: ALLOCATION OF CENTRAL POOL MBBS/BDS SEATS FOR WARDS OF CAPFS/AR PERSONNEL FOR THE ACADEMIC SESSION 2024-25: REG.

It is intimated that every year, MHA/MoH&FW allocates MBBS/BDS seats to the wards of CAPFs/AR personnel under Central Pool MBBS/BDS quota. The allocation of Central Pool MBBS/BDS seats for the Academic year 2024-25 for the wards of CAPFs/AR personnel is awaited from MHA/MoH&FW. In case of any amendment in instructions/guidelines and number of seats allocated for the wards of CAPFs/AR, the same will be intimated on receipt from MHA/MoH&FW. In the last academic session 2023-24, 26 seats for MBBS and 3 seats for BDS were allocated by MHA/MoH&FW under Central Pool quota.

02. Applications of the eligible wards of Combatised Force personnel who have qualified National Eligibility cum Entrance Test (NEET)- 2024 are to be forwarded to MHA under Govt. Scheme prescribed for central pool MBBS/BDS seats for CAPFs/AR in the following category.

- (i) **PRIORITY -I** : Wards/Widows of those Killed in Action (i.e Those who are eligible for LPA -Liberalized Pensionary awards.
- (ii) **PRIORITY-II** : Wards/widows/ wives of personnel permanently disabled in action and boarded out from service.
- (.) **PRIORITY -III** : Wards of all serving and retired personnel.

03. All the Sector IsG are requested to ensure that:

- i. The copy of application in format for sending bio-data (copy enclosed) may please be circulated to all HQRs./Estts./ Units/BNs./RTCs under your jurisdiction including retired personnel of your sector.

- ii. A copy of certificate of 10th class as proof of date of birth, mark sheet of 12th class, Result of National Eligibility cum Entrance Test (NEET) -2024, undertaking, Form-O and Medical Fitness Certificate in original and Caste Certificate (as applicable) duly self-attested by the students be attached with application form of all eligible wards of Retired/Serving personnel. Copies of prescribed format of caste certificate (i.e. SC/ST/OBC-NCL & EWS are also enclosed).
- iii. It must also be ensured that wards of Force personnel applying for both courses i.e. **MBBS and BDS, will give separate application in duplicate for each MBBS and BDS seat and indicate their preference,** as per specimen enclosed and no columns to be left blank (if applicable to the student otherwise put (x) mark in appropriate columns).
- iv. On receipt of applications of wards of force personnel of your sector, same should be scrutinized, duly verified the NEET result from appropriate website of NTA and Fit cases only be forwarded in a consolidated separate category-wise proforma (i.e. **GEN, OBC(Creamy layer), OBC(NCL), SC, ST, EWS and PwD**) for both courses (MBBS and BDS) **(in Excel Sheet only)** form so as to reach to this Directorate (Welfare branch) **by 20.06.2024** for further necessary action.
- v. It must also be kept in view that applications are accompanied by a merit list (as per enclosed proforma duly mentioning the above category i.e. **Priority-I, Priority-II & Priority-III**) in duplicate each for MBBS and BDS drawn in descending order duly countersigned by the Unit in-charge ensuring that information so furnished in the application form are correct in all respect.
- vi. It shall be necessary for the candidates to obtain **minimum marks at 50th percentile at NEET-2024** . In respect of candidates belonging to SC/ST the minimum marks shall be at **40th percentile**, in respect of candidates with specified disabilities, the minimum marks shall be at **45th percentile**. The percentile shall be determined on the basis of highest marks secured in the All India common merit list in NEET-2024 for admission to MBBS/BDS.
- vii. Piece meal, incomplete & incorrect application will not be entertained.


