

## Woman CISF constable thwarts snatching bid by two men, nabs one

**New Delhi:** In a display of bravery and quick thinking, 30-year-old CISF female constable Supriya Nayak successfully thwarted a chain-snatching attempt and apprehended a suspect during her morning walk near her residence in Pandav Nagar, close to Akshardham metro station, on Wednesday.

"Around 7.45 am, constable Nayak, who is posted in the CISF unit that guards Delhi Metro, was approached from behind by two male assailants on a motorcycle who attempted to snatch her chain. Demonstrating exceptional composure under pressure, she promptly reacted to the threat and managed to apprehend one of the culprits, while the other escaped on the bike," said Shrikant Kishore, deputy inspector general and chief public relations officer, Central Industrial Security Force.

He added that constable Nayak called for assistance, and people nearby rushed to her aid. She immediately contacted Delhi Police's PCR helpline number. Delhi Police personnel arrived promptly at the scene to investigate the matter.

The detained suspect was taken into custody for further necessary action. Constable Nayak was transported to Lal Bahadur Shastri Hospital for a medical examination as a precautionary measure since she suffered injuries during the scuffle with the bike-borne assailants, said a CISF official.

Director general CISF commended constable Nayak's courageous action. "Her swift response has not only prevented a crime but has also exemplified the values of vigilance, valour, and courage in service and in personal life," he said.
