Samota, CISF woman SI, summits Everest

New Delhi: In an unwavering spirit, a CISF sub-inspector Geeta Samota has successfully summited Mount Everest — the world's highest peak at 8,849 meters. She became the first women personnel from the Central para-military forces to climb to the top of the highest mountain. According to the CISF, Ms Geeta stood on the "roof of the world," a triumphant moment symbolising not just a personal victory on Monday morning. This historic achievement was the culmination of a journey that began in the humble surroundings of Chak village in Rajasthan's Sikar district, fuelled by a desire to break barriers and inspire. Apart from these monumental feats, she became the first woman from any Central para-military force to scale Mount Satopanth (7,075 meters) in Uttarakhand and Mount Lobuche (6,119 meters) in Nepal in 2019.
