It is intimated that a proposal for framing / amendment of Recruitment Rules for CISF Para Medical Staff (Combatised), Group 'C' posts is under consideration for approval of MHA / DoPT.

2. Accordingly, the Recruitment Rules of the above posts are proposed to be framed / amended with revision provisions mentioned against each as per instructions of Govt. of India: -
